We are pleased to invite doctoral students working on borders and migration and refugee mobilities to apply for an on-line PhD/Research Seminar organized by social anthropology scholars with long time experience teaching at the Aegean's University Summer School <u>Cultures, Migrations, Borders</u> (Heath Cabot, Jane Cowan, Sarah Green, Laurie Kain Hart, Barak Kalir, Flip Lindo, Evthymios Papataxiarchis, Effie Plexousaki, Marika Rombou, Katerina Rozakou). During the seminar 10 registered doctoral students will present their work followed by discussion of the topic both with a special discussant and with the rest of the group. The seminar will be addressed to the registered participants and the papers under discussion will be shared a week before among the participants, doctoral students and discussants.

The PhD seminar will be part of a two day **online workshop** we are co-organizing at the Summer School <u>Cultures</u>, <u>Migrations</u>, <u>Borders</u> together with the <u>Observatory of the Refugee and Migration</u> <u>Crisis in the Aegean</u>. The topic of the online workshop is MEDITERRANEAN MOBILITIES: EMERGENT HIERARCHIES and it will take place on 28 and 29 January 2022. The first day will be open to the public.
